World Evangelism Fund

World Evangelism Thanksgiving Fund 14-Day Challenge November 10-24, 2019

- 10th:** There are 234 Nazarene child development centers in 39 countries that provide children with opportunities to grow and learn as they learn about Christ.
- 11th:** Approximately 6,500 CCKs were distributed in the United States, and more than 20,000 were sent around the world, in 2018.
- 12th:** Shepherd Community Center in Indianapolis serves more than 500 families (1,000+ individuals) annually through dynamic programming that is designed to nurture the physical, emotional, spiritual, and academic development of those served. Please pray about getting involved in local missions such as Shepherd.
- 13th:** In 2018, 500+ latrines were constructed in 2nd - and 3rd - World Countries.
- 14th:** An estimated 70,000 people in the Bahamas needed immediate humanitarian relief after the most damaging storm ever to hit the island nation (Hurricane Dorian).
- 15th:** The Ciudadela Sucre neighborhood is located in the southwest hills on the south side of Bogotá, Colombia. It is a very poor neighborhood where the streets are not paved and many of the houses are made from recyclable material.
- 16th:** JESUS Film Teams have reported over 16 million decisions for Christ since 1998.
- 17th:** Pray for growth and outreach in our local church.
- 18th:** Nazarenes served an estimated 2,100 people in Burundi after extreme flooding, by providing emergency food aid.
- 19th:** Over 60,000 people have been directly impacted by WASH services (Water, Sanitization, Hygiene) through 2018.
- 20st:** In 2018, 3,435 children of Nazarene pastors received educational support through NCM's child sponsorship program.
- 21st:** On December 25, 2016, members of Mansfield First Church of the Nazarene in Texas had a Christmas service on the lawn, as their burned church building smoldered nearby.
- 22nd:** The Nazarene higher education system of schools includes 51 colleges, universities and seminaries, located in more than 120 world areas on six continents, and more than 50,000 students who annually make Nazarene institutions their schools of choice.
- 23rd:** *Against the Flow* (ATF) is a radio program in Manila, Philippines, and has a listening audience of 15-million people. To produce and air one-minute of ATF it costs \$2.19. Yes, you read that right....\$2.19 for one-minute of airtime in which 15 people could hear the gospel.
