





World Evangelism Fund 14-Day Challenge

November 8-22, 2020

8th: A total of 5,250 School Pal-Paks were distributed in 2018. Destinations included: Armenia, Guinea, Moldova, & Ukraine. 9th: A total of 1,573,608 Crisis Care Kits were distributed in 2019.

10th: Shepherd Community Center in Indianapolis serves more than 500 families (1,000+ individuals) annually through dynamic programming that is designed to nurture the physical, emotional, spiritual, and academic development of those served. Please pray about getting involved in local missions such as Shepherd.

11th: In 2017, \$2.46 million was given in Alabaster offerings for construction projects worldwide.

12th: A 7.5 magnitude earthquake struck Indonesia's Sulawesi island on September 28th, triggering destructive tsunami waves as high as 6 meters (20 feet). More than 1,200 people were killed and 800 were seriously injured. The earthquake and subsequent waves damaged more than 65,000 homes and displaced more than 60,00 people.

13th: Up to 90% of homes and buildings were destroyed in the hardest hit areas of Hurricane Dorian.

14th: Pray for the hearts of drug cartel members who kidnap, kill and terrorize Christians in some Latin American countries.

15th: There are several countries that still have restricted access to missionaries and Bibles.

16th: Leaders from Sierra Leone and Liberia shared recently about, due to the Ebola epidemic, leaders who went by bike daily to deliver food to quarantined families.

17th: Almost a billion people in our world are living without access to clean water. As a result, the leading cause of death worldwide is illness due to waterborne disease, lack of sanitation, and poor hygiene practices.

18th: Approximately 400,000 people worldwide are being served by new or adapted Covid-19 Nazarene ministries.

19th: On December 25, 2016, members of Mansfield First Church of the Nazarene in Texas had a Christmas service on the lawn, as their burned church building smoldered nearby.

20th: Five graduate seminaries, 30 undergraduate Bible/theological colleges, 14 liberal arts institutions, 2 nurses training colleges, and 1 teacher training college had a 2017 combined enrollment of 50,799 students globally.

21st: Over 150,000 people have been mobilized through Work & Witness since its beginning in 1974.
